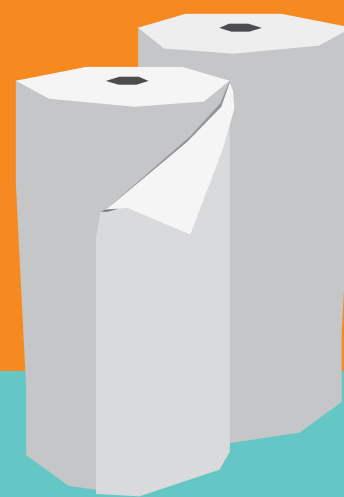
## AFTER A BODILY FLUID SPILL

Wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) during the cleaning procedure.

- Waterproof gloves, and in some cases, goggles, aprons, or masks.



Use absorbent material to soak up and contain the spill. Wipe the area clean.



Pour disinfectant (1 part bleach to 9 parts water mixture, unless using a commercially prepared product) onto contaminated area and let it sit for 10-30 minutes.



Wipe the area clean. Discard the paper towels/bodily fluid material in a nonabsorbent trash bag. Seal the trash bag and throw away in the dumpster.



Separate any clothing that was used when cleaning the spill.



Thoroughly wash hands.
